Free Software for Pupils

We have been asked by the council to include the following in our newsletter –

“As part of the Council’s Microsoft Licensing Agreement, pupils with a Glow account in Dumfries & Galloway are entitled to benefit from free Microsoft Office products on their own hardware at home. To access this offer, pupils will find a tile on their Glow Launchpad (they may need to scroll through the pages to find this). The tile looks like this:

This will enable pupils with a Glow account to install Microsoft Office onto five devices; this can be on PC, MAC or Android/IOS. When activating the software for the first time the pupil will be asked for their full Glow email address which will be username@glow.sch.uk, after which they will be asked to log into Glow as normal.

To keep the software active on the pupil’s devices, the pupil must sign into their Glow account at least once every 30 days. As Glow accounts are deactivated upon leaving the school, this means the software will cease to function if/when the pupil leaves school.

We hope to be able to continue this opportunity of accessing free software for pupils with future licensing agreements.”
